
## SHREE CHANDRAPRABHU JAIN COLLEGE, MINJUR ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2018-19

Ours is a unique college among the suburban colleges of the University of Madras.


Education for all the three years in specific cases. It is a proud privilege to declare that our Alumni are employed in Major Cities in and outside India

More than 160 computers with unlimited internet supply speak about the care and concern of the Management in providing quality education. 




